Who can enter the poster contest?

- The poster contest is open to all youth throughout York Region
- The posters may only be created by a single participant. Group submissions for the poster contest are not permitted

Who can enter the video contest?

- The video contest is open to all youth throughout York Region
- Group submissions are permitted for the video contest

Why should I participate?

- Help promote human rights, unity, equity, diversity and inclusion in York Region
- Receive special recognition at the YRP International Human Rights Day Celebration on Thursday, December 8, 2022
- The posters will be displayed in schools and public areas throughout York Region

How do I enter?

 Physical poster or digital copies on a USB Drive or CD (in either .jpg or .pdf format) may be submitted, either in person or mailed

Entries are due on Friday, June 10, 2022.

When will the winning students be informed?

• Contest winners will be informed by Friday, Nov 11, 2022

How and when will the winning students be recognized?

• All winners will be invited on stage to receive a certificate in recognition of their achievement and the prize money at the YRP International Human Rights Day Celebration on Thursday, December 8, 2022

Will the Poster be returned?

Contest Rules

Poster Submission:

- Required size: 11" x 17" (tabloid) size
- Digital copies should in either be in .jpg or .pdf format
- Encompass the theme of *Resiliency Through Community*

All submissions must include the following information:

- First and last name
- Grade and school (if applicable but not required)
- Telephone number
- Email address
- Title of submission
- The posters may only be created by a single participant. Group submissions are not permitted

Video Submission:

- Students are invited to create a video, minimum length a minute and a half to a maximum length of four minutes, reflecting the theme of *Resiliency Through Community*
- Create your video and submit it on a CD, USB stick or google doc link

All submissions must include the following information:

- Title of submission
