

York Regional Police/Community Youth Leadership in Social Justice Scholarship Application Package

Purpose

To recognize secondary school students who demonstrate leadership in the areas of equity, inclusion and social justice, within their school and/or the broader York Region community.

Awards

Ten scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded to graduating students from York Region secondary schools who have applied to attend a post-secondary institution in a full time capacity for September 2019 or January 2020 Ten students, representing the different Municipalities within York Region, will be selected as recipients. One of the ten scholarships will be awarded to an Indigenous student.

Criteria

- 1. Candidate must be a York Region resident and graduating from a York Region secondary school in June 2019.
- 2. Candidate must have applied to attend a post-secondary institution as a full-time student beginning in September 2019 or January 2020.
- 3. Candidate must have demonstrated leadership towards the goals of equity, inclusion and social justice in one of the following areas: ability, age, culture, gender, gender identity, language, race, religion, sexual orientation, socio-economic status.
- 4. Candidate must also display continued success in their academic studies, attendance and school involvement.
- 5. Candidate must submit a 1-2 page written statement that describes their motivations in working to achieve equity, inclusion and/or social justice goals.
- 6. Candidate must list any extra-curricular contributions made throughout their years as a secondary school student.
- 7. Candidate must list any significant contributions made to the community throughout their years as a secondary school student.
- 8. Candidate must submit one recommendation letter from a school staff member and one letter of character reference from a community member.
- 9. Candidate will consent to the release of their high school transcripts to support this application.
- 10. Candidate will consent to the publication of their name and image by the York Regional Police, if selected as a scholarship recipient.

Submission Process

- 1. Completed package should contain the following:
 - Part 1: Application form, 1-2 page written statement, list of extra-curricular activity and list of contributions to the community
 - Part 2: Academic Achievement
 - Part 3: School staff member's recommendation letter
 - Part 4: Character Reference from community member (cannot be a relative)
